Scale of assessments for the apportionment of the expenses of the United Nations (Article 19 of the Charter) (A/72/713) [item 140]

The General Assembly took note of the letter from the Secretary-General ([A/72/713](#)) concerning 14 Member States which were in arrears in the payment of their financial contributions to the United Nations within the terms of Article 19 of the Charter.

Sport for development and peace: building a peaceful and better world through sport and the Olympic ideal: solemn appeal by the President of the General Assembly (A/72/700) [item 11]

The General Assembly resumed its consideration of agenda item 11.

The General Assembly took note of the solemn appeal made by the President in connection with the observance of the Olympic Truce (A/72/700) (decision 72/549).

The General Assembly thus concluded its consideration of agenda item 11.

New Partnership for Africa's Development: progress in implementation and international support: Causes of conflict and the promotion of durable peace and sustainable development in Africa: draft decision (A/72/L.31) [item 66 (b)]

The General Assembly resumed its consideration of sub-item (b) of agenda item 66.

The representative of Rwanda made a statement, in the course of which she introduced draft decision A/72/L.31.

The representative of the Secretariat made a statement.

The General Assembly adopted draft decision A/72/L.31 (decision 72/550).

The representative of the United States made a statement in explanation of vote after adoption.

Statements were made by the representatives of Equatorial Guinea (on behalf of the African States), the European Union (on behalf of its member States) and Israel.
